TSA initiative to create increased employment opportunities with the commercial laundry sector.

SHORT TERM

- Government to commit as early as possible to remove all restrictions and restore confidence in the hospitality sector enabling the laundry sector to plan for the future.
- Government to review deadline for **Settled Status** applications (30th June) and reassure workers overseas that they can return.
- TSA and the industry to promote the jobs and careers in the sector, work with **UK Hospitality** to lobby Government ministers to talking up the supply chain sector at every opportunity.
- Industry will continue to work in collaboration with **DWP** to make sure **Kickstart** works to the fullest for young people and the sector.
- **HMT** to immediately freeze the liquidation of employers' Apprenticeship Levy funding to allow industry to invest in high-quality training.
- Promote and support the **Textile Operative Apprenticeship Level 2** with increased participation.
- Government to amend the **Shortage Occupation List** (SOL) and ensure that drivers and other vital roles are added to the list.

MEDIUM TERM

- Review the impact of the new immigration system and its effect on the competitiveness and recovery. of the hospitality and supply chain sector and the wider economy.
- Review alternative employment routes for access to labour.
- Use technology to reduce requirement for labour.
- Continue to make the industry a more inclusive and diverse place of work.
