TSA's Safety Summit brings the industry together to share progress, strengthen safety culture and focus on practical actions that continue to raise standards across the sector. Led by TSA and the H&S Steering Group, the programme combines industry case studies, updated guidance and interactive learning.

The Summit will review progress since last year, including key trends from industry reporting and how leadership and shared learning can make safety more engaging and effective. Fire safety will be a central theme, with a case study and practical session covering common issues, compliance and risk management. Delegates will also take part in a powerful CPR and recovery session, followed by hands-on CPR skills training.

The afternoon will focus on machinery safety and revised standards, alongside an industry panel on what good safety practice looks like in laundries. The day will conclude with a keynote session on manual handling and ergonomics, before closing remarks and networking.
